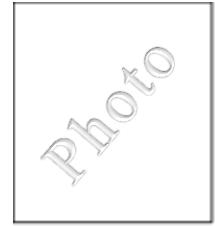

Checklist for applicant

1. Nomination Criteria for the “Excellence Teacher”

- In order for a teacher to be nominated for this award, 90% of students in that class should have sat in the exam and 100% of the students who sat in the exam should have passed.

Note: This is awarded to all teachers who pass the Nomination Criteria.

2. Nomination and selection Criteria For the “Best performance Teacher”

Following Criteria should be passed in order for a teacher to be nominated for the “best performance teacher” award.

- 90% of the students from the class should have sat in the exam for that subject.
- 75% of students from the class should have passed from that subject
(As a pass its considered ‘C’ and above)
- Should have taught to the same grade in 2 semesters.
- Should have scored more than 80% in the previous year’s appraisal from.

Note: When two different teachers are teaching the same subject for two classes of the same grade, both the teachers can be nominated, if the above mentioned criteria are met.

Below it’s mentioned the Selection criteria for “Best Performance Teacher”:

- 75 marks are given in accordance to the percentage of students passed from the subject.
For example if 80% of students in the grade passed, calculation is done as followed:
 $80/100 * 75$
- 25 marks are given in accordance to the percentage scored from the Personal appraisal form
For example if the teacher has scored 80% from the appraisal form, points are calculated as followed:
 $80/100 * 25$
